About GNLU International Moot Court Competition

GNLU International Moot Court Competition (GIMC) is the flagship event of Gujarat National Law University. It was launched in 2009 with the objective of serving as a platform for testing the legal acumen and potential of law students from India and abroad, on contemporary legal issues under the broad theme of international trade law. GIMC, which successfully completed its 8th edition in February 2016, has created a niche for itself in the moot court circuit as the only international moot court competition in India pertaining to International Trade Law.

It is with great pride and pleasure that we introduce before you yet another edition of GIMC, the 9th GNLU International Moot Court Competition, 2017 (GIMC '17), which is scheduled to be held from 1st February, 2017 to 5th February, 2017.

End Sought to be achieved through Collaboration

In order to help ensure that there is adequate representation at the moot court competition from developing countries, and so that the aim of learning beyond the competition continues, Gujarat National Law University invites expressions of interest from institutions interested in sponsoring students of developing countries for their participation in GIMC '17.

Collaborators could include law firms, international and regional trade organizations, educational institutions and knowledge databases, and any other institution which wishes to further the participation of students from developing countries in order to enable them to become acquainted with the practical application and enforcement of the law in the field dealt with by the competition.
