Work must not have been published, submitted or accepted elsewhere. The final decision on publication is taken by the Editorial Board. The Board reserves the right to edit articles.

### **Instructions to be Followed for Submission of your Manuscript**

1. Down load “**Academic and Research Integrity and Consent to Publish Policy Form**”.
2. Take print out of the “**Academic and Research Integrity and Consent to Publish Policy**” Form fill according to the given instructions.
3. Format your manuscript according to the instruction to author.

## **INSTRUCTION TO AUTHORS**

Submission should be between 4,000 to 4,500 words in length.

Submission must be in MS Word.

Main Text: Garamond, font size 12, 1.5 spacing, justified with a margin left 1.5 inch and right 1.0 inch and bottom 1 inch. The first line of the paragraph is not to be indented.

Footnotes: Garamond, font size 10.

Citation: The Chicago Style (15<sup>th</sup> edition)

## **RESEARCH ARTICLES SHOULD BE DIVIDE INTO THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS :**

1. Title
2. Abstract
3. Key words
4. Introduction
5. Result and Discussions
6. Conclusion
7. Footnotes

### **1. TITLE :**

- The full title of the paper without abbreviations. The title should be informative as possible, specifying clearly the content of the article.
- Full names of authors and their affiliations, of all authors indicating the corresponding author in astriek mark (\*).
- Paper Title: CAPITAL LETTERS. 14 point type, Bold (Garamond)

- Author(s): Capitalize, 12 point type, Bold (Garamond)

- Affiliation(s): Word case, 10 point type (Garamond )

## **2. ABSTRACT:**

- The abstract of the manuscript should not exceed 250 words.

- The abstract should include 5-6 Keywords.

## **3. TEXT :**

- Text type should be 12 point Garamond. Text should be single spaced.

Examples of Subheading Style :

### **1. FIRST LEVEL HEADING**

(14 point, bold, caps, Garamond font, numbered)

#### **1.1. Second Level Subheading**

(12 point bold, Title case, Garamond, numbered)

##### **1.1.1. Third level subheading**

(10 point bold, Title case, Garamond, numbered)

#### **4. TABLES**

Tables must be numbered with Arabic numerals in the order in which they are cited in the text. They should have a brief descriptive title placed at the top. Footnotes can be included below the table. Table caption should be 12 point Garamond italic.

The figures (photographs, Charts) must be numbered with Arabic numerals. Footnotes can be included below the figure.

Figures that include more than one image should be labeled as a, b, c, etc. (lower case, use black bold according to the figure.). The figure must include brief descriptive title and a subtitle must be provided for each image.

**Figure should appear soon after the citation in the text or if it is too large at the end of the manuscript.**

#### **5. LEGENDS/CAPTIONS FOR FIGURES**

Text type should be 12 point Garamond italic (eg; Figure 1. Caption). A caption should be provided for each figure. The legend should be typed into the manuscript, directly beneath the figure. Legends are to be listed in numerical order, labeled as “Figure 1”, “Figure 2”, etc.

For Book Reviews, please mention all details of the Subject of the review clearly. You will need to Specifically mention the Name of the Book itself , Name of Author, Name of the publisher, price , edition numbers and ISBN Number of the Book.
