## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**1) Who is Eligible to participate in the Competition?**

The competition is open to all persons enrolled bonafide on a regular basis as students in any undergraduate/ postgraduate law course or its equivalent conducted by an institution/college/university.

**2) Can More than one team participate from one Institute/ College/ University?**

As per the rules of the competition, only one team can participate from a Institute/ College/ University.

**3) How many members a team can have?**

A team can have a minimum of two members and/or maximum of three members.

**4) Is there any provision for a Team Coach?**

The Official Rules of the Competition do not recognize any team coach. However a team is free to consult anyone in preparation for the competition provided it does not violate the Official Rules of the Competition.

**5) How a Team can register for the Competition?**

Registration for the competition is a two step process. The Registration Form which is available on the website and has also been sent along with the invite should be filled and sent to the address mentioned therein. Along with the registration form a Registration fee should also be sent to the organizers. The Registration fee for the teams from India/Developing countries/ Least Developing countries is INR 3000. The teams from Developing countries/ Least Developing countries may pay in INR or its equivalent to US\$ or Euro. The Registration Fee for the other Teams is US\$ 200.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **6) What is the Deadline of the Registration of the Team?**

Please refer to the Official Schedule of the Competition which is provided on the Website.

### **7) How the Registration Fee can be paid?**

The teams from India have to pay the registration fee through a Demand Draft. All other Teams have to pay the Registration Fee through Bank Transfer. Please refer to the annexure to the Rules for Registration.

### **8) Is there any provision for waiver from the Registration Fee?**

Teams from Developing countries/ economies (excluding India)/ Least Developing Countries are eligible for Waiver. Please refer to the Official Rules of the Competition for classification of the Developing countries/ economies/ Least Developing Countries.

### **9) What is the Procedure for applying for the Waiver?**

Teams who are eligible for waiver may apply for the same by filling the waiver form. The waiver form is available on the website and has also been sent along with the invitation form. The Final decision in this regard would rest with the Organizing Committee.

### **10) Can a Team's registration Information be changed?**

A team may request the Organizing Committee for change(s) in the registration information. However any such change(s) is subject to the approval by the Organizing Committee.

The official Language of the Competition is English.
