Consent to Publish Form

It is necessary that Authors provide a formal written *Consent to publish* before publication of the Journal or Publication. The signed *Consent* ensures that GNLU has the author's or the authors' (hereinafter "the Author") permission to publish the contribution to the Journal/Publication. The Publisher hereby requests the Author to complete and return this form promptly.

- 1. The Author hereby grants to the GNLU the non-exclusive license to publish the Article named above. GNLU shall have the right throughout the world to publish, and/or to license the Article in all languages, in whole or in part, including, without limitation, any abridgement and substantial part thereof, in journal form and in any other form including, without limitation, mechanical, digital, electronic and visual reproduction, electronic storage and retrieval systems, including internet and intranet delivery and all other forms of electronic publication now known or hereinafter invented.
- The Author understands and fully endorses that the Publisher can publish the Article in its Open Access service: the unlimited right of unpaid access to the full text of the Article; the unlimited right to copy, paste, download or otherwise use the Article as long as these uses are restricted to non-commercial use only and provided that due acknowledgement is made to the original Author and the original publication in the Journal. For the purpose of this agreement the use of the Article in a Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) or a course-pack, shall be considered non-commercial.
- 2. The Author retains the right to post or deposit the Article in a subject or institutional repository, including, that of or designated by the research founding body that (co)financed his/her research, as long as the posting or depositing of the Article serves no commercial goal. The Author ensures that the Journal and the Publisher are properly credited.
- 3. The Author retains the right to publish the Article in a volume of his own work.
- 4. The Author declares that he/she or the supporting Organization, as detailed below, shall pay an Article Publishing Fee of the sum of into the account of the GNLU, as determined by the GNLU, on account of the costs of publication.

- 5. The Author warrants and represents that the Article does not infringe upon any copyright or other right(s), and that it does not contain infringing, libelous, obscene or other unlawful matter, that he/she is the sole and exclusive owner of the rights herein conveyed to the Publisher, and that he/she has obtained the customary permission for use both in print and electronically from the copyright owner of his legal representative whenever a passage from copyrighted material is quoted or a table or illustration from such material is used. The Author will indemnify the Publisher for, and hold the Publisher harmless from any loss, expense or damage occasioned by, any claim or suit by a third party for copyright infringement or arising out of any breach of the foregoing warranties as a result of publication of the Article. The Article shall be delivered to the Publisher free of copyright charges.
- 6. The Author guarantees that the Article has not been previously published elsewhere or that if it has been published in whole or in part, any permission necessary to publish it in the Journal has been obtained and provided to the Publisher together with a statement of the original copyright notice.
- 7. The Author declares that any person named as co-author of the Article is aware of the fact and has agreed to being so named.
- 8. GNLU shall have the right to protect the Article against unauthorized use and to authorize dissemination by means of off prints, legitimate photocopies, microform editions, reprints, translations, and secondary information sources such as abstracting and indexing services including databases.
