## Integrated Law Degree with Honors - Eligibility Criteria

To ensure that students with consistent high level of performance in terms of academic, research, and other activities, <u>only</u>, are eligible to be awarded Honors Degree, the following shall apply to students seeking to obtain Honors degree in the five years integrated degree course.

A student shall be awarded honors degree, if he/she shall

- 1. achieve Excellent or above grade (8 or above out of 10) and clear all papers in the first attempt, except, medical reasons or *force majeure*;
- 2. produce three research papers during his/her five year degree course. A Research Evaluation Committee for Students, comprising of the Dean, Academic Affairs, Deputy Dean, Academic Affair and Subject Teacher shall evaluate the research papers;
- 3. have two or more marks out of five for goodness, in all subjects and in all semesters;
- 4. pass basic knowledge requirement of one of the languages Sanskrit, Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Japanese, Russian, Spanish, Swahili, as determined by the GNLU in consultation with the concerned language teachers/schools/institutions;
- 5. review at least one book of his/her choice and publish the same during his stay at the GNLU; and
- 6. shall write one research paper of his/her choice on any particular legal subject/issue of a foreign jurisdiction;

This academic directive shall come into effect from 1 July 2011 and shall be applicable to students who enrol at the GNLU from July 2011 academic year.
