

Notification: Inviting Expression of Interest for seeking Admission under the Sports Quota for UG Programmes for the Academic Year 2019-20

1. Gujarat National Law University invites application for admission under sports category from the outstanding players who have represented at International/National level in the registered tournaments organized by the Central or State Government or by any authority recognized by Central or State Government.
2. The admission is available for UG programmes offered by the University The total number of seats for the 2019-2024 under sports category are 4 (2 for girls and 2 for boys).
3. The candidates appearing in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2019 and interested in seeking admission under the Sports Quota Category for LL.B. Programmes, subject to satisfying eligibility criteria and fulfilling all of the below mentioned conditions, can apply directly by sending expression of interest by filling the '[Admission \(Expression of Interest\) Form](#)'.
4. The hard copy of the filled-in admission (Expression of Interest) form shall reach the University through post latest by 5th July, 2019.
5. The Application fee **INR 2,500/-** (non-refundable) shall be sent along with the hardcopy of the Admission (Expression of Interest) form in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of the Gujarat National Law University payable at Ahmedabad.

4. Eligibility Conditions:

- (a) A candidate seeking admission under sports category shall have appeared in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) and shall have represented at International/National level in the registered tournaments organized by Central or State Government or by any authority recognized by Central or State Government in the above-mentioned games.
- (b) The candidates securing minimum 40% of the highest score of the CLAT – 2019 shall only be considered eligible for admission under this category. For example: If the CLAT – 2019 highest score is 150, then, only the candidates who have secured minimum of 60 marks or above shall be considered eligible for admission under this category.

5. Selection Process:

- (a) **Weightage:** 40% weightage shall be given to the marks secured in the CLAT examination and out of remaining, 30% weightage shall be given to the performance in the sports activities (assessment shall be done on the basis of certificates produced) and 30% weightage shall be given on the basis of performance in the trials conducted by the University.

(b) Verification of Certificates and Panel of Experts: The assessment/verification of certificates/medals shall be done by the University. The University shall form a panel of experts to judge the potential of the candidates and trials shall be conducted by them. The constitution and composition of members of the panel shall be the sole discretionary of the University. The University in consultation with the panel, shall decide upon the format of the trial and has a right to modify/amend the format whenever it deems appropriate/fit. The decision of the panel shall be final for selection of the candidates.

(c) List of Sports: The admission for the Academic Year 2019-20 under sports category is limited to the following games. The trials shall be conducted for all the following games or some of the games, depending upon the receipt of the applications (Expression of the Interest Form) by the University.

1. Athletics (All events of track and field)
2. Badminton
3. Football
4. Basketball
5. Tennis
6. Volleyball
7. Throw-ball
8. Cricket
9. Table-Tennis
10. Chess
11. Carrom
12. Swimming

(d) Weightage of Marks for the Certificates/Medals:

(e) Tie Breaker policy:

In a scenario wherein two or more candidates secured the same marks in the same Game or Sports and are eligible to secure admission in the same course in the GNLU then tie-break is done by the Admission Committee as per the below mentioned criteria:-

- (a) The candidates securing higher marks in CLAT examination will be given higher preference.
- (b) If the Tie still persists, then applicant securing higher marks in Sports trials will be given preference.
- (c) If the Tie persists for Chess and Tennis, the following criterial shall be applicable:-
 - (i) Chess: The candidates having the FIDE rating 1700
 - (ii) Tennis: The candidates having the AITA ranking up to 300 for under 18 years boys/girls or ranking up to 500 for open (Men/Women) category.

The rating/ranking for Chess & Tennis on the day/week of publication of advertisement for admission under sports quota shall be considered.

Note: The candidates shall be required to produce evidence of their certificates at the time of Personal Interview/Admission.

6. The shortlisted candidates for appearing for trials shall be intimated in due course of time.
