# Notification No. SS/03/NRI-PG/25072023 Inviting Expression of Interest for seeking Admission under the Non-Resident Indian (NRI) for PG (LL.M.) Programme (s) for the Academic Year 2023-24.

Gujarat National Law University invites applications for admission under the Non-Resident Indian (NRI) category for PG (LL.M.) Programme(s) for the Academic Year 2023-24. The seats under the NRI Category shall be filled by the University directly from the merit list of the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2023. The candidates appeared in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2023 and who are interested in seeking admission under the NRI Category for PG Programmes, subject to satisfying eligibility conditions, can apply directly to the University.

1. No. of Seat(s): PG - 02

### 2. Eligibility:

- a) A candidate seeking admission under the NRI category shall have to fulfil any one of the below-mentioned conditions:
  - i. At least one of the parents of such candidates shall be a Non-Resident Indian and shall ordinarily be residing abroad as a Non-Resident Indian;

OR

 The person who sponsors the candidate for admission shall be in the first-degree relation with the candidate and shall be ordinarily residing abroad as a Non-Resident Indian;

OR

iii. If the candidate has no parents or no near relatives or has not been taken as a ward by some other nearest relative, such candidates may also be considered for admission under the NRI category, provided that the guardian has bonafidely treated the candidate as a ward and shall be able to file an affidavit indicating the interest shown in the educational affairs of the candidate and his/her relationship with the candidate. Further, such person (guardians) shall be a Non-Resident Indian and ordinarily residing abroad as a Non-Resident Indian;

OR

iv. The Person of Indian Origin (PIO) and Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) cardholders are also eligible for admission under the NRI seats available at GNLU.

#### 3. Application Form and Fees:

The candidates, who are interested in seeking admission under the NRI Category for PG Programme(s), subject to satisfying eligibility conditions, can apply directly by clicking the below link along with all the relevant certificates which needs to be uploaded latest by 31 July 2023 (11:00 A.M.). The Application fees of INR 10,000/- (non-refundable) shall be made through the following link:

  - Step 11: On successful payment, a confirmation e-mail will be delivered to the given e-mail id.

The Candidates may upload the documents or can edit the application form till 31 July 2023 by 11:00 A.M. The candidates are advised to fill the form in full. Incomplete application form (including non-submission of documents) shall be rejected.

#### 5. Selection Process:-

The selection of candidates shall be purely on the basis of CLAT Ranking, out of the application(s) received by the GNLU under this category. The application received after the due date shall not be considered.

#### 6. General Instructions:

- i. The candidates appearing in the qualifying examination shall be required to produce evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
- ii. The students who have passed their qualifying examination from schools located outside India (affiliation boards other than CBSE, ISCE, IB and Cambridge) are required to produce the equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian University. - iii. The candidate(s) applying under PG Programme are required to submit their final year mark sheet of LL. B. Programme at the time of admission.
- 7. The Candidates seeking admission under this category are required to submit the following documents at the time of applying against the said category. The candidates are required to submit the original of the same at the time of the admission:-
  - CLAT Admit Card and Result/Scorecard (Screenshot)
  - Certificate-from-Competent-Authority-NRI-or-FN-Candidates
  - <u>Certificate of Non-Resident Indian (NRI) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)/Persons</u>
     <u>of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holder Sponsor (NRI Category)</u>
  - <u>Certificate of Sponsorship for Admission in LL.B./LL.M. Programme (NRI/FN Category)</u>

All the candidates shall provide the passport copy/details of the Sponsor with the Application Form.
