Notification: Inviting Expression of Interest for Seeking Admission under the Sports Category for UG (LL.B.) Programme for the Academic Year 2022-23.

Gujarat National Law University invites applications for admission under the sports category from the outstanding players who have represented at the International/National level in the registered tournaments organized by the Central or State Government or by any authority recognized by the Central or State Government. The admission is available for UG programme offered by the University. The candidates appearing in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2022 and who are interested in seeking admission under the Sports Quota Category for LL.B. Programme, subject to satisfying eligibility criteria and fulfilling all of the below-mentioned conditions can apply directly to the University.

1. Number of Seats:

UG Programme (LL.B.) - 4 (Girls:2/Boys:2)

2. Eligibility Conditions:

- a) A candidate seeking admission under the sports category shall have appeared in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) and secure a minimum 40% of the highest score of the CLAT–2022. For example, if the CLAT–2022 highest score is 150, then the candidates who have secured a minimum of 60 marks or above are eligible for admission under this category.
- b) The applicant as per their age must be eligible to participate in Inter-University Competitions for the next three years.

3. Application and Fees:

The candidates, who are interested in seeking admission under the Sports Quota for UG Programmes, subject to satisfying eligibility conditions, can apply directly by filling the 'Admission (Expression of Interest) Form for Sports Quota as mentioned below.

The Application fee INR 4,000/- (non-refundable) shall be made through the following link:-

4. The candidates may please follow the step-by-step instructions/flowchart given below for making an application:-

- Step 1: Click on URI: https://gnlu.servergi.com:8071/OLAGNLUUGPG/Student/welcome
- Step 2: Click UG for Under Graduate Course
- Step 3: Enter the Personal Information
- Step 4: Choose Sports Quota under "Application for Admission Category" head
- **Step 5:** Enter Address
- Step 6: Accept T&C
- Step 7: Click on Save
- Step 8: Click on Submit button to pay the online payment of application fees.
- Step 9: On successful payment, a confirmation e-mail will be delivered to the given e-mail id.

5. Selection Process:

- a) **Weightage:** The admission under this category shall be on the basis of weightage of the CLAT score, Sports certificates and performance in the trials. 40% weightage shall be given to the marks secured in the CLAT examination. 30% weightage shall be given to the past five years performance in the sports activities (assessment shall be done on the basis of certificates produced) and 30% weightage shall be given on the basis of performance in the trials conducted by the University.
- b) Verification of Certificates & Trials: The assessment/verification of certificates/medals shall be done by the University. The University shall form a panel of experts to judge the potential of the candidates and trials shall be conducted by them. The constitution and composition of members of the panel shall be the sole discretionary of the University. The University in consultation with the panel, shall decide upon the format of the trial and has a right to modify/amend the format whenever it deems appropriate/fit. The decision of the panel shall be final for selection of the candidates.

6. List of Sports:

The admission for the Academic Year 2022-23 under sports category is limited to the following games. The trials shall be conducted for all the following games or some of the games, depending upon the receipt of the applications by the University.

7. Weightage of Marks for the Certificates/Medals:

For a particular year, only the highest certificate shall be considered for scoring.

For example: if a candidate has played district, state and national level games in a particular year, his national certificate will only be considered for that year.

Also, if a candidate has participated in an individual or a team event, or different types of event, only one certificate will be considered. : Table tennis – team events and individual events, the candidate is supposed to submit the highest of them.

If a candidate has represented India in an official tournament recognized by the Sports Association/Federation, that candidate will be automatically selected.

[#]Please note that the University reserves the right to revise the above mentioned point system as and when it deems fit. Only highest score of the particular certificate weightage shall be considered for marking. The highest score shall be scaled down to 30% for the purpose of calculation irrespective the number of certificates.

Important Note:

- 1. Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/Open/Prize Money League/Ranking competitions shall not be considered.
- 2. Any injury/ casualty caused to the applicant during Sports Trials shall be the sole responsibility of the Applicant.
- 3. It is mandatory to submit an Undertaking on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper by the applicant at the time of admission stating that he/she will play for the Gujarat National Law University during their Under-Graduate programme of study.

8. Tie Breaker policy:

In a scenario wherein two or more candidates secured the same marks in the same Game or Sports and are eligible to secure admission then a tie-break policy will be applied by the Admission Committee as per the below-mentioned criteria:-

- a) The candidates securing higher marks in CLAT examination will be given higher preference.
- b) If the Tie still persists, then applicant securing higher marks in Sports trials will be given preference.
- c) If the Tie still persists for Chess and Tennis, the following criteria shall be applicable:-
- d) Chess: The candidates having the FIDE rating 1700
- e) Tennis: The candidates having the AITA ranking up to 300 for under 18 years boys/girls or ranking up to 500 for open (Men/Women) category.

The rating/ranking for Chess & Tennis on the day/week of publication of advertisement for admission under sports quota shall be considered.

9. Important Dates:

- a) The Last date for submission of Online Application Form: 15 July 2022
- b) Trials: 18-19 July 2022
- c) Declaration of Result: 20 July 2022
