Roles and Responsibilities:

Under the guidance of Principal Investigator/ Co-Investigators, the incumbent shall perform the following roles and responsibilities in project titled “Women Safety Audit of Aurangabad City” funded by National Commission for Women.

- (i) Provide research assistance to Principal Investigator/ Co-Investigators;
- (ii) Conduct interdisciplinary research in view of aim and objectives of the Project;
- (iii) Developing qualitative and quantitative tools, and making qualitative and quantitative research analysis;
- (iv) Collecting data, compilation of datasets and interpretation of data analysis and report writing;
- (v) Participate and present the research work in Conference/ Symposium as per guidance of Principal Investigator/ Co-Investigator;
- (vi) Perform project related duties including administrative, coordination, etc. required to achieve the aim and objectives of the project;
- (vii) Any other research or project related work which may be assigned by the Principal Investigator/ Co-Investigator;

Essential Criteria:

- (i) Master’s Degree or a higher degree (M. Phil/ Ph. D) in Law/ Social Work/ Sociology/ Management (OB & HRM specialization) with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited Foreign University;
- (ii) Good knowledge of latest national and international research trends and developments in Law;
- (iii) Working experience in MS Office, basic knowledge of information technology;
- (iv) Strong analytical skills, excellent English writing and communication abilities and the ability to manage research projects;
- (v) Excellent research and writing skills;
- (vi) Working knowledge of Hindi;

- (i) Research experience in the area of Women and Law/ Gender Studies;
- (ii) Experience in handling Qualitative and Quantitative data;
- (iii) Working knowledge of Marathi.
