- (v) Provision of full time / part-time scholarships and fellowships for conducting research in legal, economic, socio-legal, social, technological, entrepreneurial aspects of new and emerging IPR areas (National and International) of interests.
- (vi) Setting up of a repository for IPR related information and case studies at the university both in physical and electronic form.
- (vii) Preparation of repertoire of resources / toolkit / guidance / instruction materials for various levels of IPR courses in education services for direct teaching as well as teaching through distance education mode / online courses including commissioning of suitable resource persons for the purpose.
- (viii) Studies commissioned by DPIIT, are to be necessarily conducted by the IPR chair. A synopsis / concept note, in this regard, will be provided by the IPR Chair to DPIIT before taking up such study.
- (ix) Facilitate filling of IPR applications (by way of copyrights, patents etc.) to further strengthen IP as a key driver for India's knowledge driven economy. The future focus of research will be on mutual

Essential Criteria:

- (ii) LL.M with at least 55% of marks in IPR Specialization (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
