GNLU Team wins the prestigious Red Cross International Humanitarian Law Moot

Gandhinagar, March 23, 2018: A GNLU team comprising Ms Samira Mathias, Mr Raghav Bhargava and Mr Naman Lohiya (students of the five-year integrated programme at GNLU) emerged winners of the 16th Red Cross International Humanitarian Law Moot 2018 held in Hong Kong from 7th to 10th March 2018. The GNLU team also secured awards for their written submissions and oral presentation.

The Moot was an Inter-University competition in the Asia-Pacific Region, co-organized by the Hong Kong Red Cross and the International Committee of the Red Cross in collaboration with the University of Hong Kong and the Chinese University of Hong Kong. 24 teams from 18 countries participated in the moot held at the University of Hong Kong and the Hong Kong High Court.

This is the first time GNLU has won the prestigious Red Cross Moot.

GNLU was the winner of the coveted Indian Mooting Premier League for 2017. This achievement, along with GNLU's win at the India Rounds of the 59th Phillip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition, Top 16 at the Willem C. Vis. East Hong Kong Arbitration Moot 2018 and the win at the 2nd AIAC-ICC Pre Moot for the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration, is bound to give GNLU a head start in the upcoming 2018 edition of the Mooting Premier league.
