The Former First Secretary of International Court of Justice Visits GNLU

Mr. Witteveen is a Dutch judge and legal writer. He was the First Secretary of the International Court of Justice (ICJ), The Hague, where he has had 35 years of working experience. In April 1996 he published a book on 'The International Court of Justice 1946-1996' with Arthur Eyffinger. Mr Witteveen is also a prominent benefactor of the university. He has secured donations of books and reports of invaluable amount to GNLU library. His latest assistance includes facilitating donation of books by Judge Pieter Kooiman, former Judge, ICJ and Foreign Minister of the Netherlands, and helping GNLU's national-round winning Jessup Team.
