GNLU Organises Certificate Course on Military Laws

Centre for Public International Law, Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) is organising a 6-day Certificate Course on Military Laws. In its constant endeavour to facilitate and enrich the legal fraternity with the knowledge of advancement and development in the contemporary subjects and issues, GNLU, from time to time, organises various modules of courses.

The Certificate Course on Military Laws aims to acquaint the participants with the process of law in defence forces, starting from reporting of a case to sentencing, appeals and available remedies. It will make the participants familiar with the court-martial proceedings in detail by conducting moot court-martial simulation. It also aims to acquaint the participants with Armed Forces Tribunal Act and Rules, including drafting and the skill of pleading before these tribunals. Dr. Col. R.D. Dr. Sharma was Regional Law Officer in HQ Coast Guard at Andaman and Nicobar region; Joint Director (legal) in DG Assam Rifles, Shillong; and AAG (legal), AJAG, Corps HQ, and AJAG (command), Col. (D&V) respectively, in 15 years of his service tenure. He has served Indian Army for 28 years and after retirement he has been a practising lawyer in Delhi for about 4 years. He is the first Scholar In-Residence at GNLU.

The course will run from 14th to 19th March, 2016. Legal fraternities including students, practitioner and academic across India are participating in this course.
