Certificate Course on "Cross-Border Challenges in Corporate Law" inaugurated at GNLU

Gandhinagar, Aug 30, 2019: A three-day Certificate Course on Cross-Border Challenges in Corporate Law was inaugurated at Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), today.

In her inaugural address, Dr Mamta Biswal, Dean Academic Affairs said, "In view of the recent developments like the Jet Airways cross border insolvency issue and cross borders mergers announced by Reliance Industries & Shopsense Retail Technologies as well as Walmart & Flipkart, the course provides a timely forum for discussion about legal issues highlighting the interface of the company law with private international law."

"In the era of globalization, with the markets, people and services crossing borders, the entire global economy is expanding and the related legal issues are intensifying," said Dr Umakanth Varottil, resource person for the Course. Dr Varottil is an Associate Professor at Faculty of Law, National University of Singapore and a visiting faculty in various leading law schools in Australia, India, Italy, New Zealand and the United States.
