No. 61/2016 Selection of GNLU Faculty for ICCR Rotating Chair Professorship at University of Hannover, Germany

Greetings from GNLU!

Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), being a Research-based Teaching university, in continuation with providing the best academic growth to its faculty members, is delighted with yet another achievement by one of its faculty member. Dr. R. K. Singh, Associate Professor of Law at GNLU, has been selected for deputation as ICCR Rotating Chair at the University of Hannover, Germany for a period of one semester commencing from October 2016.

The Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), in consultation with Indian Missions abroad, has established Chairs of Indian Studies in various foreign universities. The purpose of these Chairs, apart from educating foreign students about India, is to become a nucleus around which Indian Studies could develop in academic institutions abroad. The academics/scholars deputed to these Chairs not only teach courses on various aspects of India, but through other academic activities — like research guidance, seminar co-ordination, publications, delivering public lectures — develop scholarly interactions with the academics of that country and assist in disseminating information on India and in creating a better appreciation of various India related issues.

It is for the first time that any GNLU faculty member has been selected for deputation as ICCR Rotating Chair. Under this Fellowship, Dr Singh will be teaching two courses, namely, 'Comparative Contract Law (with Elements of Electronic Contracts)' and 'Indian Constitutional Law in a Comparative View'. Besides, he will also be delivering a lecture in the quite prominent European Legal Practice Programme (ELPIS)-Colloquium.
