[GNLU Acquires Lloyd's Shipping and Maritime Law Reports from 1919 to 2016](#)

GNLU Library has acquired an entire collection of Lloyd's Shipping and Maritime Law Reports from 1919 to 2016, a total of 216 bound volumes. Lloyds Law Reports are the globally acclaimed law reports on Shipping and Maritime Law. The Reports are held as an authority by the Lloyds agent internationally. The Reports cover mainly shipping and maritime law but in recent times, they have included cases on commercial law.

Gujarat Maritime Board which has established a dedicated chair on Maritime Law is one of the benefactors of this collection. GNLU organizes International Maritime Academy annually bringing policy-makers, officials from navy, shipping and insurance companies, scholars, students among others from all parts of the world. The Collection includes the first reported case, namely, Nitrate Producers steamship Co. in which the Nitrate Producers steamship co. of London appealed from a judgment given against them upon their claim brothers, Ltd. Shipbuilders of Sunderland, in respect of delay in the delivery of the steamship, built by the defendant for the plaintiff under a contract dated Nov. 21, 1914. The latest reported case includes Essar Oilfields services Ltd. v. Norscot Rig Management Pvt. Ltd. (2016).
