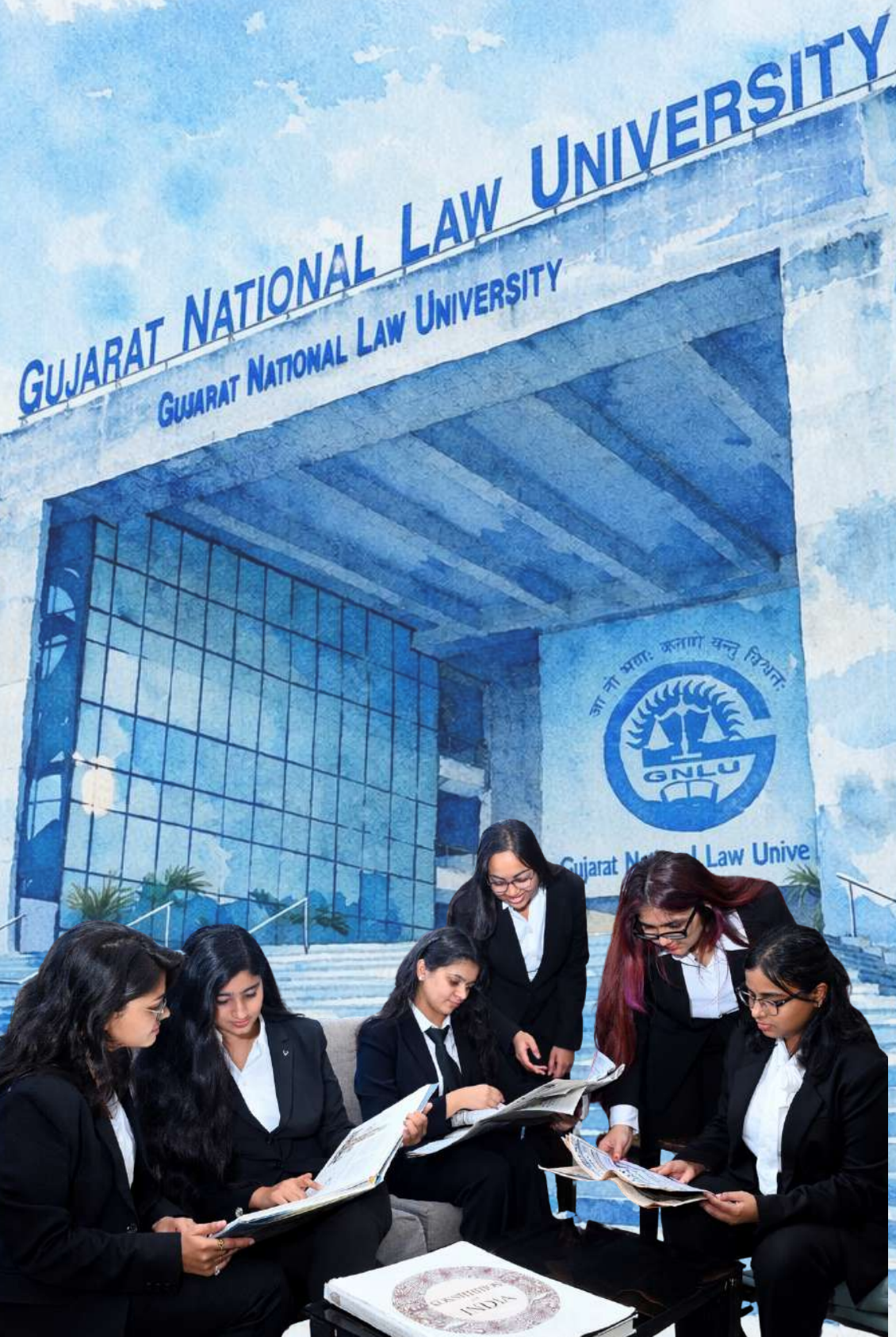

Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) is a statutory university established by the Government of Gujarat under the Gujarat National Law University Act, 2003, and functions as the nodal agency for the upliftment of legal education in the State. The University is recognised by the Bar Council of India (BCI) and the University Grants Commission (UGC). The University is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and is accredited with an 'A' Grade by NAAC. The GNLU Act, 2003 proclaims the objectives of the University “shall be to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge of the law and legal processes and their role in national development; to develop in the students and the research scholars a sense of responsibility to serve society in the field of law by developing skills regarding advocacy, legal services, legislation, parliamentary practice, law reforms and such other matters; to make law and legal processes efficient instruments of social development; and to promote the interdisciplinary study of law in relation to management, technology, international cooperation and development.” The University is instrumental in providing a multi-disciplinary LLM Programme and a five-year integrated course in humanities, commerce, management, science, and social work.
