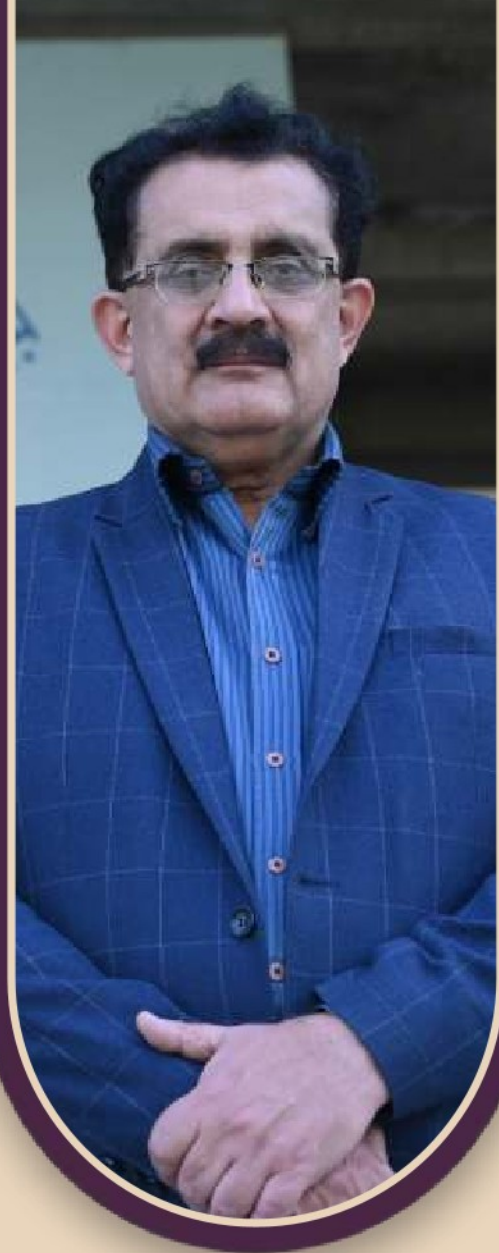

About Gujarat National Law University

Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) is a statutory university established by the Government of Gujarat under the Gujarat National Law University Act, 2003 and functions as the nodal agency to uplift legal education in the State. The University is recognized by the Bar Council of India (BCI) and the University Grants Commission (UGC). The University is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and is accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC.

The GNLU Act, 2003 proclaims that the objectives of the University shall be to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge of the law and legal processes and their role in national development; to develop in the students and the research scholars a sense of responsibility to serve society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy, legal services, legislation, parliamentary practice, law reforms and such other matters; to make law and legal processes efficient instruments of social development; and to promote the interdisciplinary study of law in relation to management, technology, international cooperation and development. The University is instrumental in providing multi-disciplinary, five-year integrated courses with general honours - BA LLB, BBA LLB, B.Com LLB, B.Sc. LLB and BSW LLB.

GNLU is a legal institution with global outreach, which undertakes a continuous, dynamic process of creating legal minds who are par excellence professionals with an innate sense of social responsibility. With state-of-the-art research facilities and readily-accessible campus infrastructure, the students, faculty, and research fellows are well-equipped to pursue their research interests.

GNLU's library is a vast expanse of knowledge with resources available on countless areas of law and provides access to online research databases and journals. This holistic, on-ground exposure has honed their ability to navigate complex human dynamics, a critical asset for the modern legal professional.

From reviving student-run initiatives to setting new benchmarks in moot court competitions and legal aid camps, the Class of 2027 has demonstrated that the true essence of legal education lies in community and collaboration. They stand today not just as academically proficient graduates, but as seasoned individuals who have lived and breathed the full "GNLU Experience", making them uniquely prepared to seamlessly integrate into and lead within the corporate and legal fraternity.



University Initiatives

1. GNLU Litigation Assistance and Support Scheme (GLASS)

The GNLU Litigation Assistance and Support Scheme (GLASS) is a distinctive initiative aimed at encouraging graduates to pursue careers in litigation. Recognizing the financial challenges that often accompany the early years of practice at the Bar, the scheme provides monthly financial assistance to selected graduating students who demonstrate strong academic performance and a clear commitment to litigation. Through this initiative, the University seeks to support aspiring litigators and contribute to strengthening the legal profession by enabling talented graduates to pursue courtroom practice without immediate financial constraints.

2. Legal Services Committee

The Legal Services Committee (LSC) at Gujarat National Law University is dedicated to providing pro bono socio-legal assistance and community outreach. The Committee operates three legal and social aid clinics located at the GNLU campus, Koba Village, and Sabarmati Central Prison, through which students engage in legal awareness and assistance programmes.

LSC regularly conducts initiatives addressing issues such as promotion of primary education, adult literacy for campus housekeeping staff, awareness for street vendors, menstrual hygiene campaigns, and public discourse series (Lok Manch) on matters of social justice. The Committee is supported by a panel of advocates practicing before the Gujarat High Court, who extend free legal assistance to beneficiaries involved in disputes.

Additional initiatives include Lok Adalat awareness programmes, "Know Your Rights" mentoring sessions in government schools, and RHA food drives. To strengthen its outreach efforts, the Committee has also introduced Nyaya Rath, a dedicated vehicle for conducting off-campus legal aid and awareness activities inaugurated in the presence of the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India.

3. GNLU Academic Support Programme (GASP)

The GNLU Academic Support Programme (GASP) promotes a culture of peer learning and academic collaboration within the University. Under the programme senior students conduct academic support sessions for junior batches, assisting them in understanding core subjects, clarifying concepts, and developing effective study strategies. Alongside these sessions, GASP runs a structured mentorship programme in which senior students are allotted mentees from junior batches. Mentors provide guidance not only on academics but also on navigating campus life, managing coursework, and adapting to the demands of legal education. The programme has also introduced a PwD initiative, aimed at extending additional academic and peer support to students with disabilities, thereby fostering a more inclusive and accessible learning environment.

4. AI-Enabled Virtual Moot Court

Gujarat National Law University has introduced an AI-enabled Virtual Reality Moot Courtroom, designed to enhance experiential learning in advocacy and courtroom practice. The platform enables students to participate in simulated court proceedings through artificial intelligence and immersive virtual reality technology, providing a realistic training environment for developing advocacy skills. Developed in collaboration with Maersk Training, the initiative represents a significant step towards integrating advanced technological tools into legal education. The virtual courtroom was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India, reflecting the University's commitment to innovation in legal training.

5. Specialized Academic and Professional Training

Through its various Centres of Excellence, Gujarat National Law University regularly conducts specialized training programmes and academic courses in emerging areas of law. The University has organised Space Law courses for officers of the armed forces, reflecting its engagement with advanced legal domains relevant to national security. Further, in collaboration with the Indian Coast Guard, GNLU also offers specialized training and short-duration courses on International Maritime Law and the Law of the Sea. Additionally, the University conducts courses for students in areas such as Capital Markets and Securities Law, Corporate Law, Intellectual Property Law, and FinTech, in collaboration with leading law firms in India, strengthening the interface between legal education and professional practice.

At the institutional level, the Intra Moot Court Competition, conducted every semester, provides students with an opportunity to engage with contemporary and complex legal issues while developing essential advocacy skills. 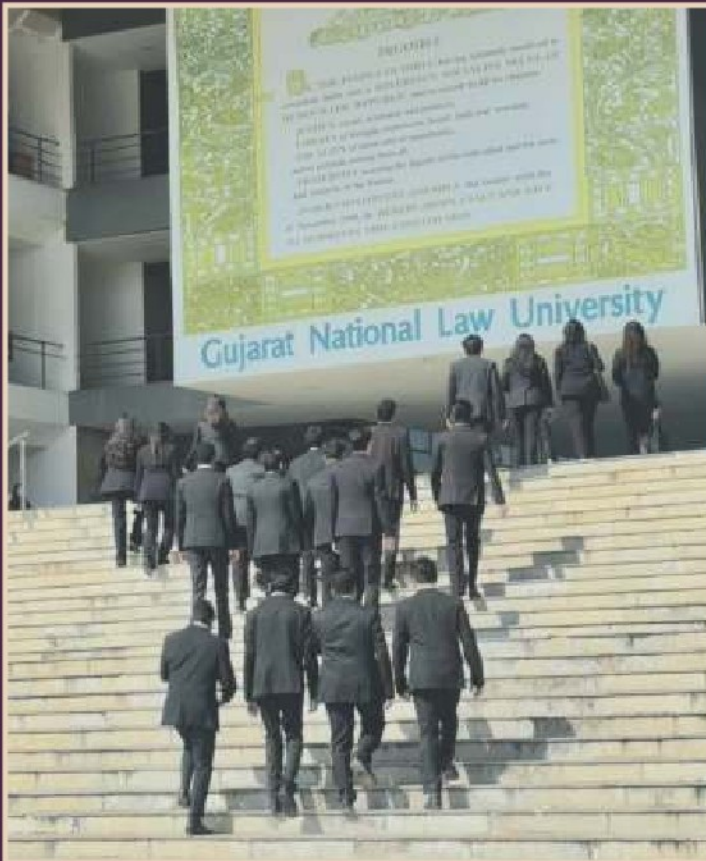
