Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) Gandhinagar is inviting tenders invites sealed tenders for supply, installation, testing & commissioning of Split A/C Electrical Wiring work in 192 Rooms of Boys and Girls Hostel in the premises of GNLU campus. You are requested to quote your best offer along with the complete details of specifications, terms & conditions.

General Conditions

The tender should be submitted in two parts i.e., Technical Bid and Financial Bid. The Technical Bid and the Financial Bid should be sealed by the bidder in two separate covers as under: -

- a) "Technical Bid" for supply, installation, testing & commissioning of Split A/C Electrical Wiring work in 192 Rooms of Boys and Girls Hostel.
- b) "Financial Bid" for supply, installation, testing & commissioning of Split A/C Electrical Wiring work in 192 Rooms of Boys and Girls Hostel.
- c) Both sealed envelopes should be placed in a main/bigger envelope super-scribed as "Tender for supply, installation, testing & commissioning of Split A/C Electrical Wiring work in 192 Rooms of Boys and Girls Hostel in the premises of GNLU campus".

1. Documents comprising Technical Bid.

- iii. Each page of tender document duly signed & stamped.

Eligibility Criteria

- x. Bidder should have minimum 3 years' experience in electrical installation works.
 - xi. Bidder should have executed similar electrical works in educational institutions, commercial buildings, hostels, hospitals, offices etc.
 - xii. Average annual turnover during last 3 financial years shall not be less than 30% of estimated cost.
 - xiii. Bidder should possess valid GST, PAN, Electrical Contractor License and Labour registrations.
2. Documents comprising the financial bid. Financial Bid be given as per the format at Annexure-IV. Rates must be quoted as per format specified, failing which tender shall be summarily rejected.

3. Instructions to Tenderer

- a. All relevant information asked for in the tender shall be provided in the given formats.
- b. Tender duly completed shall be submitted at Gujarat National law University, Gandhinagar in a sealed envelope on or before the time indicated.
- c. Technical and Commercial bids are to be submitted in separate envelopes superscribed as Technical Bid or Commercial Bid as the case may be.
- d. Tenderers are required to furnish information about similar works handled, staff held and infrastructure etc in technical bid.
- e. Tender document to be accompanied by EMD for **Rs 30,000/-** in the form of Demand Draft in favor of Gujarat National law University, Gandhinagar payable at Ahmedabad to be attached with the application.
- f. Commercial bid to include BOQs with price schedule duly filled, signed and stamped on each page.
- g. Tenderer to check that all amounts filled in BOQ are arithmetically correct.

- h. All section wise total amounts shall be written in words also. Cutting/overwriting shall not be accepted.
- i. Completion time will be 90 days from the issue of work order/Agreement. The bidder shall submit a detailed work schedule/bar chart within 7 days from the date of issue of work order indicating the activity-wise completion timeline.
- j. **All bidders should visit site prior to giving quotes to get acquainted with the site conditions.** No demand shall later be entertained due to site conditions. Time of visit is 27 July 2026 to 31 July 2026 **(11AM to 04PM)**

4. Scope of Work

- (a) General Scope of Work. SITC of wiring for Standalone ACs in Rooms at hostel at GNLU premises.
- (b) Detailed Scope of Work.
 - i. Providing and fixing PVC box/enclosure for Double Pole MCB including all necessary fittings and accessories complete
 - ii. Providing & erecting 240 V MCB double pole switch for motor, AC & inductive load (C Curve) having 10 KA breaking capacity & confirms to IS: 8828 in existing box having following capacity 16 Amp. (Hager, Legrand and ABB equivalent Make)
 - iii. Providing and erecting Mains with 1.1 KV grade FRLS PVC insulated ISI marked stranded Copper conductor wire in following type of pipe to be erected concealed in /flushed on wall/ceiling, with 1.5 sq. mm copper conductor FRLS PVC insulated stranded wire of green colour for earth continuity of following size (b) 2 wire 2.5 sq. mm (Polycab, RR Kable or equivalent make)
 - iv. - vi. Providing and erecting approved make RCCB/ELCB conforming to IS:12640, 2 Pole (Phase & Neutral) suitable for 230V, 50Hz single phase supply, having sensitivity of 100 mA and short circuit withstand capacity of 10 kA, quick acting tripping mechanism without electronic components, complete with all accessories and erection in existing panel as directed for 63 Amp rating (Hager, Legrand and ABB or equivalent make).
- vii. Providing and erecting approved make 125 Amp, Four Pole MCCB suitable for 415 Volt, 50 Hz AC supply having required breaking capacity with fixed thermal and magnetic release complete with all internal connections, spreader copper connections, required size copper lugs, nuts, bolts etc. in existing panel after dismantling/removing existing 63 Amp MCCB including testing and commissioning complete as required. (Hager, Legrand and ABB equivalent Make)
- viii. Providing and erecting XLPE (IS:7098)(I)-88 ISI armoured cable multistrand Aluminium conductor for 1.1 KV. to be laid on wall with necessary clamps or in existing trench / pipe of following size of cables 3 1/2 core 35 Sq. mm (16 Sq. mm 1/2 core) (Polycab, RR Kable or equivalent make)
- ix. Removing existing undersized Single Pole MCBs from existing Distribution Board (DB) and providing & fixing new Single Pole MCBs of suitable capacity complete in all respect as required.
- x. Complete specifications are enclosed at annexure-I.
- xi. List of approved makes is enclosed at annexure-II

5. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).

The bidder shall be required to submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for an amount of **Rs 30,000/-** by the way of demand drafts only. The demand draft shall be drawn in favor of "Gujarat National Law University, Gandhinagar". The demand draft for EMD must be enclosed in the envelope containing the Technical Bid. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after the successful submission of Bank Guarantee/Security Deposit and for unsuccessful bidder(s) it would be returned after award of the contract. Bid(s) received without demand draft of EMD will be rejected. Following aspects to be noted by the bidder:-

- i. Request for transfer of any previous deposit of earnest money or security deposit or payment of any pending bill held by the respect of any previous work will not be entertained.
- ii. Tenderer shall not be permitted to withdraw his offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. In case the tenderer fails to observe and comply with stipulation made herein or backs out after quoting the rates, the aforesaid amount of earnest money will be forfeited.
- iii. The tender without EMD will be summarily rejected. The firms who are registered with National small Industries Corporation (NSIC) small-scale industries (SSI) are exempted to submit the EMD (Copy of registration must be provided along with the technical bid).
- iv. The EMD, in case of unsuccessful bidders shall be retained at GNLU, Gandhinagar till the finalization of the tender. No interest will be payable by the GNLU, Gandhinagar.

6. Site Visit

Qualified/ responsible representative shall visit the site to take site instruction/decision from the Registrar/designated representative. Please refer para **3(j)** in this regard.

7. Rates

Rate should be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR) on Door Delivery Basis at GNLU, Gandhinagar inclusive of all charges. If there is a difference between the rates in figures and words, lower of the two rates shall be taken as valid and correct rate.

8. The sealed quotations/tender, super scribed with the name of the work, reference number and due date for tender opening, should be submitted in person or by post. However, the Institute shall not be responsible for delay or loss of tenders in transit or any postal delay.

9. Opening of Tender

The tenderer is at liberty either himself or authorize not more than one representative to be present at the opening of the tender. The representative attending the opening of tender (on behalf of the tenderer) should bring with him an Authority Letter from the tenderer and proof of identification. Tenders received late at GNLU, Gandhinagar, will be ignored. Further, GNLU, Gandhinagar does not accept any liability and responsibility for the tenders that are not properly sealed and marked and/or sent late.

Evaluation of Bids

Technical Bid shall be evaluated first.

Financial Bid of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened.

Technical qualification shall be based on:

- Eligibility criteria
- Similar work experience
- Financial capability
- Statutory registrations

Contract shall normally be awarded to L1 responsive bidder.

10. Tender Inviting Officer reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof and also does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender.

11. Delayed/ late/ conditional bids/tenders shall not be accepted.
12. Warranty / Guarantee. Bidder must provide two (02) year or more comprehensive on- site warranty and it will start from the date of takeover of project in good working conditions, against the defects of any, workmanship and poor quality of the components. No offer of the bidder will be accepted without warranty/ guarantee of their supplied/ installed goods. During warranty period, all defective materials/components shall be replaced free of cost including labour, transportation and testing charges.
13. Validity of the Bids. The quoted rates must be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of closing of the tender. The overall offer for the assignment and quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the validity quoted is shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive and it may be rejected.
14. In case the tenderer withdraws, modifies or change his offer during the validity period, bid is liable to be rejected and the EMD shall be forfeited without assigning any reason thereof. The tenderer should also be ready to extend the validity, if required, without changing any terms, conditions etc. of their original tender.
15. Signing of Contract. The successful bidder shall be required to execute the Contract Agreement accepting all terms and conditions stipulated herein on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- (Rs. One Hundred only) within fifteen days of the issue of the Letter of notification of award along with PBG. In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to sign the Contract within the period stipulated above, the EMD shall be forfeited and the acceptance of bid shall be considered as cancelled.
16. Force Majeure. In the event of any delay or failure in performance of obligations due to causes beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor or the Employer, including but not limited to natural calamities, war, strikes, epidemics, or government restrictions, such obligations shall be suspended for the duration of the Force Majeure event.

17. Bidder shall submit a copy of the tender document and addendum/ corrigendum thereof, if any, with each page of the document signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the entire terms and conditions as mentioned in the tender enquiry document.
18. Breach of Terms and Conditions. In case of breach of any terms and conditions as mentioned in tender, the Competent Authority, will have the right to reject the bid at any stage without assigning any reason thereof and nothing will be payable by GNLU, Gandhinagar. In that event, the EMD shall also stands forfeited.
19. Legal Jurisdiction. The agreement shall be deemed to have been concluded in Gandhinagar, Gujarat and all obligations hereunder shall be deemed to be located at Gandhinagar, Gujarat and Court within Gandhinagar, will have Jurisdiction to the exclusion of other courts.
20. Arbitration. All the disputes of any kind in connection with contract shall be referred to the College Administration for settlement. For legal remedies, jurisdiction of District Courts Gandhinagar shall apply.
21. Applicable Law. The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/processing.
22. Removal of Material/ Installations. GNLU, Gandhinagar, during the progress of work holds power to order in writing, removal from the work site, any material/installations which in their opinion are not as per specifications or instructions, and for carrying out rectification/rework within specified time and contractor shall carry out such removals/rework as per specification at his own cost. The owner/engineer can get such rectifications/rework done from other agencies at the cost of contractor, if the same are not carried out by them in the stipulated and agreed period.
23. Labour Laws. Existing labour laws in Gandhinagar District shall apply. All laws related to Labour, PF, ESI, medical insurance etc. shall be adhered to by contractor. No child Labour shall be employed by the contractor. However,

contractor shall not be absolved from the responsibility of maintaining site insurance in toto.

24. Compensation for Delay (LD Clause). If the Contractor fails to complete the works and clear the site on or before the date(s) fixed for completion, he shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy of Board on account of such breach, be liable to pay one per cent per week subject to maximum of 10 % of the contract value.

25. Security Deposit (PBG). Every intending bidder who wish to participate in the bidding process shall submit his bid in the manner prescribed with requisite earnest money & tender fee as prescribed in the contract documents/ tender documents. The tender fee (if applicable & mentioned in the bidding document) shall be non-returnable. Further the earnest money of the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after or before award of the contract to successful bidders as decided by the Project Consultant. Further, 5% Performance Security deposit shall be payable by the successful bidder within two weeks from the date of signing of the agreement. The earnest money deposited with the contract shall be retained by the Board (of successful bidder only) and shall form part of performance security deposit for which the successful bidder shall be required to submit the difference in amount or Bank Guarantee for the entire security amount as prescribed under the contract. The performance security deposit shall be released after successful completion of defect liability period as applicable under the contract. In the event of any defects observed during defect liability period, the Project Consultant shall give notice to the contractor to rectify the defects in a reasonable period. In the event of the contractor failing to remove the defects within prescribed period the Project Consultant may get the defects rectified by any agency of his own choice at the risk and cost of the contractor. All compensation or other sums of money payable by the Contractor to the Govt./ Board under the terms of this Contract or under any other contract with Govt./ Board may be deducted from, the Security Deposit or from any sums which may be due or may become due to the Contractor by the Govt./ Board

on any account whatsoever and in the event of his Performance Security Deposit being reduced by reason of any such deduction, the contractor shall within 10 days thereafter make good, any sum or sums which may have been deducted from or realised by encashing Security Deposit or any part thereof or by encashing bank guarantee as applicable and directed by the Project Consultant.

26. Option Clause The contract will have an Option Clause, wherein the Buyer can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms & conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within the currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract.

27. Repeat Order Clause - The contract will have a Repeat Order Clause, wherein the Buyer can order upto 50% quantity of the items under the present contract within six months from the date of supply/successful completion of this contract, the cost, terms & conditions remaining the same. The Bidder is to confirm acceptance of this clause. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to place the Repeat order or not.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

28. Co-ordination with Other Agencies. While the work under any schedule is in progress, the work under the other schedule will also progress simultaneously. Also, other agencies like civil agency, sanitary contractors will work simultaneously during the progress of work covered under any schedule of other contractors. The contractor shall not only carry out work in co-ordination with other agencies but also give them all assistance. if and as required without any extra charges.

29. Discrepancy between Specifications. In case of discrepancy in the specifications or any other aspect the matter, shall be brought by the contractor to the notice of the Registrar, GNLU, Gandhinagar for further decision.

30. Procurement of Material. The contractor shall be responsible for the procurement of all the material required to complete the work.
31. Contractor to Employ Qualified Supervisor. The contractor shall employ skilled supervisor "to supervise and execute the work.
32. Inconvenience to the Institute. The contractor shall not deposit or store any material any site without permission of the Registrar / designated representative. GNLU, Gandhinagar is an educational institute and material will be stored in such a way that there is no obstruction to the movement of students / general traffic within the institute.
33. Prevention of Accidents and Safety Measures.
- a. The contractor will take all necessary precautions against a fire during the course of his work & will ensure the work against fire at his cost.
 - b. He will also take all care against likely damage of floor, walls, doors, windows or any part of the building. In case of any damage or loss, the contractor has to make good at his own cost.
 - c. Workmen /site shall be insured and work fence shall be under the umbrella of EIC site.
34. Specifications. In the absence of specifications for any work or material, relevant Indian Standard Specifications shall be applicable.
35. Cleaning the Site. The site described and shown onsite, shall be cleared off the rubbish of all kinds etc. after completion of the work and the site shall be handed over in clean and neat condition.
36. Supply of Tools Tackles and Other Materials. For full completion of the work, contractor shall at his own expense arrange & furnish all necessary work tools, tackles, scaffolding, tagaries, mugs, scrappers, wire brushes etc. that may be required to complete the work under contract.
37. Inspection of Work. Registrar/ Consultant GNLU Gandhinagar / Designated Representative shall have access and right to inspect the work, or any part thereof at all times and places during the progress of the work. The inspection and supervision is for the purpose of assuring owner that the plans and specification

are being properly executed and while owner and / or engineer and their representative will extend to contractor all desired assistance in interpreting the plans and specifications, all such assistance shall not relieve contractor from any responsibility for the work. Contractor, without delay, shall correct any work, which proves faulty. Successful completion means entire satisfaction of AC consultant / Registrar GNLU Gandhinagar.

38. Security. The contractor shall follow security rules of Institute. The contractor should issue the identity cards to their workers. Contractor may please note that the security section is empowered to carry out the checks.
39. Damage to Adjoining Property. Contractor shall take all precautionary measures to avoid any damage to the adjoining property. All necessary arrangements shall be made at his own cost. In case it happens, contractor is liable to repair the damaged property at his own cost and no claim in this regard will be entertained.
40. The contractor shall take instructions from the Registrar, GNLU, Gandhinagar regarding collection and stacking of materials at any place. No excavated earth or building rubbish shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads, services and compound walls are under construction. Before start of work drawings etc are to be got approved from the Registrar/Consultant of GNLU.
41. Normally contractors shall not be allowed to work at night. Work at night shall, however, be allowed if the site conditions / circumstances so demand. However, if the work is carried out in more than one shift or at night, no claim on this account shall be entertained.
42. Terms of payment.
- a. The work will be inspected by Registrar/ Consultant daily basis.
 - b. No advance payment.
 - c. Payment via e-transfer against GST invoices, subject to satisfactory certification.
 - d. No escalation in rates during contract.
 - e. No part & running bill will be paid. Payment will be made only on completion of work and final submission of bill.

Note: The contractor shall take into account all the costs involved in compliance of all the special conditions and as stated above while quoting his rates in his tender for this work.
