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SECTION- A:

1. BIDDER'S MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.1 The Bidder's firm should have existence for a minimum of 3 (three) years.(Enclose Company Registration Certificate)
- 1.2 The Bidder should have qualified technical service personnel for the instrument(s) based in India.
- 1.3 The bidder should sign and submit the declaration for Acceptance of Terms and Conditions as per Annexure-C.
- 1.4 The Bidder must not be blacklisted/banned/suspended or must not have a record of any service related dispute with any organization in India or elsewhere. A declaration to this effect has to be given as per Annexure-C.
- 1.5 Copy of PAN card and GST registration certificate allotted by the concerned authorities.
- 1.6 Any information furnished by the bidder found to be incorrect, either immediately or at a later date, would render the bidder liable to be debarred from tendering/taking up of work in GNLU.
- 1.7 Offered price must include all kinds items costs, delivery, installation, training, loading, unloading, packing, unpacking, Including Tax etc.
- 1.8 If there will be any modification felt by the GNLU committee, then it will be published in form of corrigendum on GNLU website. GNLU has absolute right to accept or reject any query/request.
- 1.9 Service Setup: Bidder shall have service setup, service support team in Gandhinagar/Ahmedabad to attend the service within three days.
- 1.10 The bidder must possess valid PAN, GST registration, and comply with labour laws, safety rules, and other statutory requirements.
- 1.11 The bidder should not be blacklisted/debarred by any Government Department/PSU/Autonomous Body.

1.12 The bidder/firm shall submit satisfactory performance certificates and/or recommendation letters from at least three (03) Educational Institutions, Government Departments, Government Organizations, Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), Autonomous Bodies, or Corporations where the bidder has successfully executed similar works/services during the preceding three (03) years. The certificates/recommendations should clearly indicate the nature of work executed and satisfactory performance of the bidder.

SECTION- B:
1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1.1 The Bidder's firm should have existence for a minimum of 3 (three) years. (Enclose Company Registration Certificate) The Bidder's firm should have existence for a minimum of 3 (three) years. (Enclose Company Registration Certificate)
- 1.2 The bid must be valid for at least 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the actual date of opening of the technical bid.
- 1.3 Bidders should bid as per the financial proposal (Bill of Quantity (BOQ) attached at Annexure- A.
- 1.4 Warranty –Minimum Warranty for 5 (five) years is mandatory. Warranty period will start only once GNLU take over the items after the complete supply and installation and inspection and acceptance by GNLU of the provided item / solution. If the items are found to be defective, they have to be replaced or rectified at the cost of the bidder within 30 days from the date of receipt of written communications from GNLU. If there is any delay in replacement or rectification, the warranty period should be correspondingly extended.
- 1.5 Supply and Fixing should be completed within 30 working days of placing of order.
- 1.6 The items should be delivered, successfully installed at the site of GNLU, Gandhinagar-382426.
- 1.7 100% payment will be released after complete delivery and satisfactory installation certificate by the Competent Authority. Payment will be subject to deduction of TDS as per rules/laws. Any advance payment will not be released.
- 1.8 GNLU reserves the right to cancel or modify the EOI at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
- 1.9 As time is essence for this procurement, the successful bidder must have to adhere by the delivery and installation schedule as per purchase order, failing

which Liquidity Damage (LD) will be imposed for late delivery and installation at the rate of 0.5% of total order value for delay per week or part thereof (maximum up to 10% LD). GNLU may consider formal request for extension in delivery and installation schedule on genuine grounds, however it will be absolute right of the GNLU to accept or reject such request of the vendor. GNLU reserves the right to cancel the order if there is delay without a formal approval by GNLU.

- 1.10 Conditional offer or incomplete bids will be treated as non-responsive bid.
- 1.11 The bidder may furnish any additional information, which is necessary to establish capabilities to successfully complete the envisaged work with the technical bid. It is however, advised not to furnish superfluous information.
- 1.12 The bidder must visit the installation site before submission of tender, with prior intimation.
- 1.13 Corrigendum / addendum, if any, shall be issued as part of the tender documents and shall be published on the GNLU website (www.gnl.ac.in).
- 1.14 The award of contract will be subject to acceptance of the terms and conditions stated in this EOI.
- 1.15 The Bidder shall fill in rates for all items described in the Annexure A, Bill of Quantities (BOQ). L-1 (Lowest) will be determined based on the total price (including of all items) quoted by the bidder.
- 1.16 The Contractor shall conduct a thorough site survey and verify all dimensions, levels, and site conditions before execution. Any discrepancy observed at the site shall be reported to the in-charge officer before commencement of work.
- 1.17 The tensile fabric shall be properly tensioned and installed to ensure structural stability, efficient rainwater drainage, and resistance to local wind and weather conditions.
- 1.18 The Contractor shall be responsible for providing all tools, equipment, scaffolding, lifting arrangements, labour, and safety measures necessary for the execution of the work.

- 1.19 All installation works shall be carried out by trained and experienced personnel following established engineering practices and the manufacturer's recommendations.
- 1.20 Any damage caused to existing structures, utilities, or other property during the execution of the work shall be repaired or restored by the Contractor at no additional cost to GNLU.
- 1.21 The Contractor shall submit the manufacturer's technical data sheets, quality certificates, and warranty documents for the tensile fabric and associated components before installation.
- 1.22 The completed tensile fabric structure shall be free from wrinkles, sagging, leakage, loose fittings, and visible defects in workmanship.
- 1.23 The Contractor shall provide a warranty/guarantee against defects in materials, fittings, and workmanship as specified in the contract.
- 1.24 Final payment shall be released only after satisfactory completion of the work, inspection, and certification by the competent authority of GNLU.
- 1.25 Any deviation from the approved specifications, materials, design, or installation methodology shall require prior written approval from GNLU.
- 1.26 In case of legal dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement or breach, or the invalidity thereof, shall first be attempted to be settled by discussions. If the same is not resolved through mutual discussions, then the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Director, Gujarat National Law University or any person nominated by him. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. All disputes are subject to Gandhinagar jurisdiction only.

2. STATUTORY REQUIREMENT AND SAFETY STANDARDS:

2.1 Statutory Requirements:

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Central, State, and Local laws, regulations, codes, standards, and statutory requirements in force during the execution of the work, including but not limited to:

- 2.1.1 The Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 and Rules framed thereunder.
- 2.1.2 The Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, wherever applicable.
- 2.1.3 The Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
- 2.1.4 The Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948, wherever applicable.
- 2.1.5 The Minimum Wages Act, 1948 and other applicable labour welfare legislations.
- 2.1.6 The Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 and related safety requirements.
- 2.1.7 The provisions of the National Building Code (NBC) of India, relevant Indian Standards (IS Codes), and good engineering practices applicable to tensile membrane structures.
- 2.1.8 Fire safety requirements prescribed by the competent authority and applicable regulations.
- 2.1.9 Environmental, health, and safety regulations applicable to storage, handling, transportation, fabrication, and installation activities.
- 2.1.10 Any directions, circulars, policies, or guidelines issued by GNLU and statutory authorities from time to time.
- 2.1.11 The Contractor shall be responsible for complying with all applicable statutes, laws, by-laws, norms, rules, and regulations prescribed by the local, State, and Central Governments, as well as by the GNLU from time to time, in relation to the specified work.

The Contractor shall obtain all necessary permissions, approvals, licenses, insurance coverage, and statutory clearances required for the execution of the work and shall indemnify and keep indemnified GNLU against any claims, losses, damages, penalties, liabilities, or legal proceedings arising out of non-compliance with any statutory provisions.

2.2 Safety & Standards:

- 2.2.1 The bidder must comply with relevant BIS/IS safety standards, and safety regulations during execution.
- 2.2.2 All supporting steel, stainless steel, aluminium components, wire ropes, turnbuckles, corner plates, and fasteners shall be free from defects and conform to relevant specifications.
- 2.2.3 The fabric shall possess fire-retardant properties and comply with internationally accepted fire performance standards or equivalent certifications.
- 2.2.4 The contractor shall submit relevant test certificates for fire resistance and flame-retardant properties of the material.
- 2.2.5 Installation shall be carried out by trained and experienced personnel under proper supervision.
- 2.2.6 The contractor shall provide all necessary safety equipment, including safety helmets, safety belts/harnesses, gloves, safety shoes, scaffolding, and barricading arrangements.
- 2.2.7 Work at height shall be undertaken strictly in accordance with applicable safety regulations.
- 2.2.8 The work area shall be properly cordoned off during installation to ensure the safety of students, staff, visitors, and workers.
- 2.2.9 The contractor shall comply with all applicable labour laws, safety regulations, and statutory requirements issued by Central Government, State Government, and local authorities.
- 2.2.10 The contractor shall be solely responsible for the safety of its workforce and for any accident, injury, loss, or damage arising during execution of the work.
- 2.2.11 An undertaking for adherence to safety norms shall be submitted with the bid.

SECTION- C:

1. SCOPE OF WORK

The work under this contract includes supply installation of tensile fabric at the canteen at Gujarat National Law University.

1.3 Payment Terms:

- i. No advance payment.
- ii. Payment via e-transfer against GST invoices, subject to satisfactory certification.
- iii. No escalation in rates during contract.
- iv. Overpayments, if detected, will be recovered; underpayments rectified.
- v. No overtime work or such compensation shall be payable by the GNLU.
- vi. No compensation shall be payable by the GNLU for any loss on account of delay in commencement or execution of work.
- vii. Claims pertaining to a financial year should invariably be received by the end of the same year.

1.4 Warranty / Guarantee:

- i. The Contractor shall provide a comprehensive warranty of not less than 05 years from the date of commissioning on the tensile membrane fabric, supporting structure, welding, accessories, waterproofing performance, and workmanship. The warranty shall cover manufacturing defects, membrane deterioration, seam failures, and structural deficiencies arising from defective materials or workmanship. The Contractor shall replace or rectify any defects occurring during the warranty period at no additional cost to the Gujarat National Law University.
- ii. Any defects arising during this period shall be rectified/replaced by the contractor at no extra cost.

1.5 Liquidated Damages (LD):

In case of delay beyond the stipulated completion period, LD @ 0.5% of contract value per week, subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value, will be levied.

1.6 Defect Liability:

The contractor shall remain responsible for any defects in materials/workmanship for the warranty period and attend to them promptly.

1.7 Site Conditions:

- i. The contractor must inspect the site before quoting and acquaint themselves with existing site constraints.
- ii. The quantity shown in tender is approximate. After completion the work shall be measured. The payment shall be made as per the measurement.
