

## **Notification: Inviting Expression of Interest for Seeking Admission under NRI Category for UG /PG Programmes against the Vacant Seats for the Academic Year 2020-21**

Gujarat National Law University invites application for admission under NRI category for UG/PG programmes for the academic year 2020-21. The seats under the NRI Category shall be filled by the University directly from the merit list of the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2020. The candidates seeking admission under any of the above mentioned category can apply directly to the University.

### **1. Number of Seats:**

UG Programme (LL.B.) –01

PG Programme (LL.M.) – 01

### **2. Application and fees**

The candidates appearing in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) – 2020 and who are interested in seeking admission under NRI Category for UG (LL.B.) & PG (LL.M) Programmes, subject to satisfying eligibility conditions, can apply directly by filling the ‘Expression of Interest Form’ on or before 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020.

### **3. Eligibility Conditions:**

- a) A candidate seeking admission under NRI category shall have appeared in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) and secure minimum 40% of the highest score of the CLAT– 2020. For example, if the CLAT–2020 highest score is 150, then the candidates who have secured minimum of 60 marks or above are eligible for admission under this category.
- b) A candidate seeking admission under NRI category shall have to fulfil any one of the below mentioned conditions:
  - At least one of the parents of such candidates shall be a Non Resident Indian and shall ordinarily be residing abroad as a Non Resident Indian;
  - OR,
  - The person who sponsors the candidate for admission shall be in the first degree

relation with the candidate and shall be ordinarily residing abroad as a Non Resident Indian;

OR,

- If the candidate has no parents or no near relatives or has not been taken as a ward by some other nearest relative, such candidates may also be considered for admission under the NRI category, provided that the guardian has bonafidely treated the candidate as a ward and shall be able to file an affidavit indicating the interest shown in the educational affairs of the candidate and his/her relationship with the candidate. Further, such person (guardians) shall be a Non Resident Indian and ordinarily residing abroad as a Non Resident Indian;

OR,

- The Person of Indian Origin (PIO) and Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holders are also eligible for admission under the NRI seats available at GNLU.

#### **4. General Instructions:**

- i. The candidates appearing in the qualifying examination shall be required to produce the evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
  - ii. The students who have passed their qualifying examination from schools located outside India are required to produce the equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian University. The same certificate is required to produce at the time of admission. The detail process of AIU is available on <https://aiu.ac.in/index.php>.
