Role and Responsibilities Under the guidance of Head (Dean), Research and Head (Dean), Academic Affairs, the incumbent shall perform the following role and responsibilities;

- (ii) Plan and conduct training and extension activities such as workshops, seminars, round-table conferences etc. in relevant area;
- (iii) Provide input to legislature, executive and judiciary on latest trends and developments in IPR law and policy on a regular and upon request basis;
- (iv) Assist in IPR law and policy related activities of Microsoft India and GNLU;
- (v) Contribute towards ensuring that GNLU achieves knowledge and research excellence world-wide in IPR law and policy;
- (vi) Report on an annual and periodic basis to Microsoft India and GNLU on programs and activities, indicators of achievement, results obtained under the Chair;
- (vii) Performs any other duties including administrative as required by the Microsoft India through GNLU and by the GNLU;

Essential Criteria:

- (i) Master's Degree in Law with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

- (iii) Ability to conceptualize and organize international training workshops and brainstorming online/on-site discussions apart from teaching/Research;
