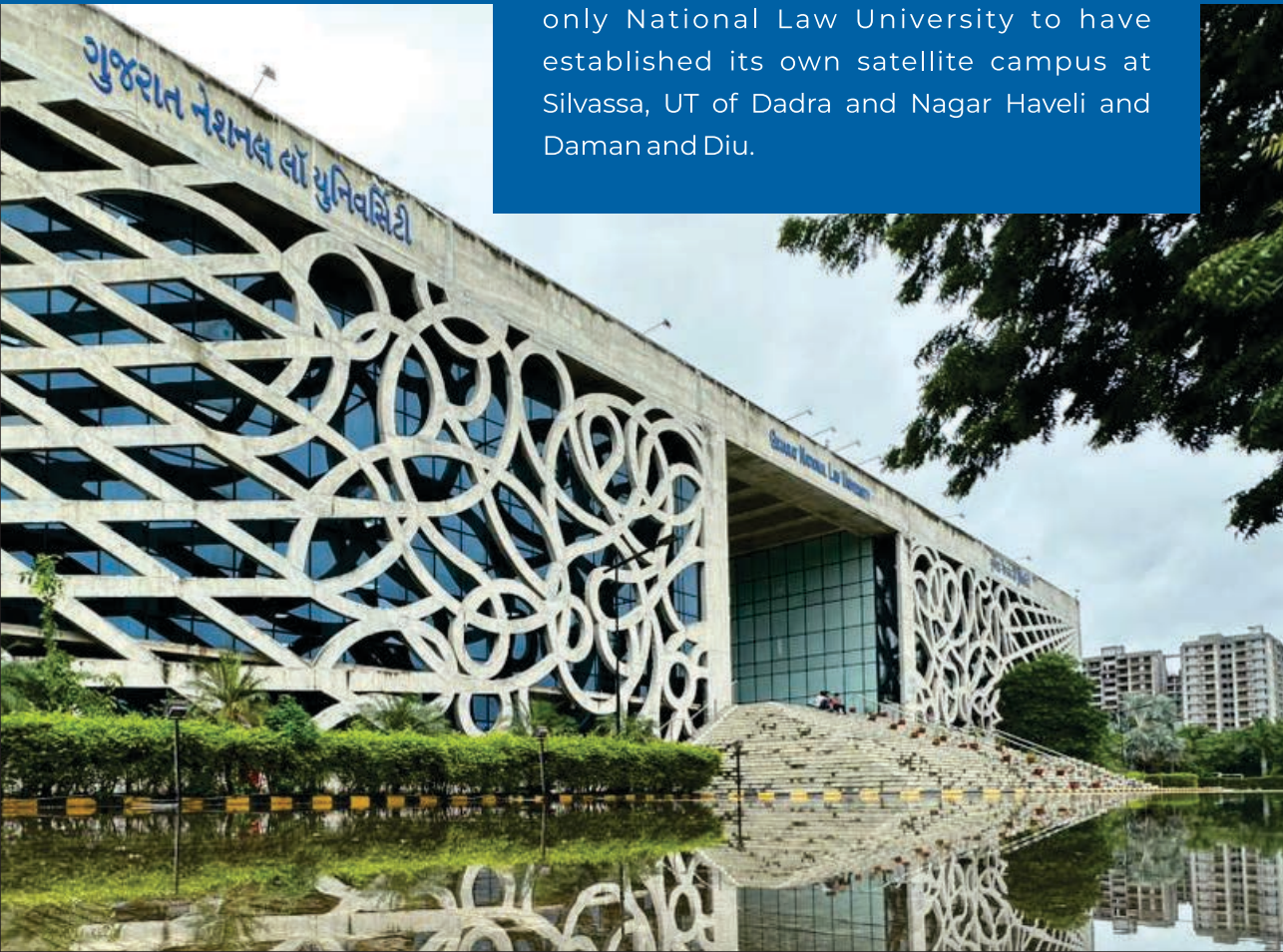

Eligibility & Selection Process

A

Mandatory Requirements

The candidate applying for this course should have completed the basic UG degree offered by any recognized national or foreign university (MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS).

The candidate should have registered with the National/State level Regulatory body as per the requirement of the specific field of medicine they are representing. (NMC/State level Medical Council/ Dental Council of India/ National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM/ any other equivalent body).

B

Desirable Requirements:

Membership of the Indian Medical Association (applicable only for candidates with MBBS).

C

Selection Process

- **Application Screening:** An expert committee constituted by IMA-GSB and Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) will review all application forms based on the eligibility criteria to determine candidate selection.
- **Entrance Exam:** If the number of eligible applicants exceeds 60, GNLU will conduct an online entrance exam, with admission offers based on the scores obtained.

D

Application Process

- **Eligibility:** Verify criteria on the previous section in the brochure or GNLU website (<https://www.gnlu.ac.in/GNLU/PG-Diploma-in-Medical-Law,-Policy-and-Ethics#parentVerticalTab5>).
- **Application Fee:** INR 1,000 (non-refundable).
- **Tuition Fee:** INR 45,000.
- **Course Extension Fee:** INR 10,000/year (applicable only for candidates unable to complete the course within the enrolled year and wishing to continue in the following year).
- **Special Exams Fee:** INR 5000/- (For those who fails to appear in regular exams and willing to write during specials in February/March 2027)
