

Procedure for Selection

1. In order to obtain admission, candidates have to appear in a written entrance exam test. This year the exam shall be conducted on Monday 26th August 2019 at GNLU Campus, Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
2. **Eligibility Criteria:** The candidate shall have a Master's Degree from a recognised University with not less than 55% marks or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale and 50% marks or its equivalent in the case of SC/ST/OBC candidates (non-creamy layer) and Persons with Disability.
3. Candidates who have qualified for UGC NET / JRF / SLET / M.Phil. are exempted from taking the admission test.
4. The entrance test will have two parts (MCQ).

Paper I – 100 Marks Multiple Choice Question (Common for all Streams)

- Research Methodology (30 Question X 2 marks each = 60 Marks)
- English (20 Questions X 2 marks each = 40 Marks)

Paper II - 100 Marks Multiple Choice Questions (50 Question X 2 marks each = 100 marks) for Law/Allied Subjects. In Allied Subjects the assessment is on domain knowledge.

5. The applicants who have cleared the entrance test with 50% score as qualifying marks and also those who are exempted from writing the entrance test are required to submit a preliminary research proposal with a statement of the research problem and a literature survey which demonstrates that the research topic is unexplored and an original scholarly contribution can be made on the same.
6. The applicants who clear the interview will be provisionally admitted to the Ph.D. programme

Note:

- 1) Proposals in the allied areas may be considered subject to the availability of supervisors and the area of interest.
- 2) Admissions against the aforesaid vacancies shall only be made if a research proposal is found to be satisfactory and suitable. The University reserves the right not to admit candidates in any specialization if the proposal is not found to be research worthy.
