

## **GNLU student invited to the World Justice Forum VI with a waiver of participation Fee**

**Gandhinagar, March 20, 2019:** GNLU student and founder of LawBriefs <<https://lawbriefs.in>>, Aditya Gor, has been invited to attend the **World Justice Forum VI** to be held at **The Hague, The Netherlands** from April 29- May 2, 2019. The fee for his participation has been waived off by the organizing committee.

This year, the World Justice Forum VI will be convened on a theme of “**Realizing Justice for All.**” Research indicates that more than five billion people around the globe lack access to justice for solving everyday problems. This significant “justice gap” affects both developed and developing countries, undermining inclusive economic development, exacerbating inequality, and eroding trust in institutions. The Forum will gather up to 1,000 global leaders from diverse disciplines, professions, and perspectives to address this challenge and broaden and strengthen the movement for the rule of law.

The four-day program will highlight key research findings on the relationship between justice and a range of development issues including public health, the environment, and inequality; showcase innovative solutions to bridge the gap; foster multi-sectoral collaboration to expand access to justice, and garner commitments from diverse stakeholders to advance the justice agenda. As a meeting place for governmental and non-governmental actors, private sector leaders, and the donor community, the Forum will address the principal challenges to delivering justice and provide space for advancing concrete solutions. It is expected that the outcomes of the World Justice Forum VI will feed directly into the UN High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 16 in July and the UN Summit on the SDGs in September.

Mr Aditya Gor is a student of the Gujarat National Law University & his start-up LawBriefs has been incubated at the GNLU Legal Incubation Council (GLIC) under the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP) scheme of the Government of Gujarat. His start-up, LawBriefs is a legal service platform that prepares case summaries of lengthy and difficult judgement. In order to make the understanding clear, Law Briefs divide the entire judgement into various parts which include- Briefs and Facts and Procedural History, Issues before the Court, Arguments raised, Ratio and decision of the court. They also provide a quick introduction to the judgement in the form of an introductory table which acts as a reference tool for lawyers.

The startup has also been selected as one of the top 5 best student startups under SSIP Policy across the state.
