

GNLU expands the network of global partners

Gandhinagar, June 04, 2020: Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) has entered into collaborative arrangements with four universities in Europe and USA for a wide-ranging collaboration in the field of academic exchange programmes for students & faculty, collaborative research, joint organization of seminars & conferences, etc. These universities are The University of Akron (USA), Ulster University (UK), University of Lausanne (Switzerland) and Texas A&M University (USA).

The arrangement with Texas A&M University will give an option to LLM students of GNLU to obtain their degree from Texas A&M University. LLM students will initially enroll at GNLU. After successful completion of their first semester, they will have an opportunity to enroll at the Texas A&M University School of Law in the second semester and complete the remaining course work there to obtain the degree from Texas A&M University.

Under the collaborative arrangement between GNLU and University of Lausanne, Switzerland, both universities have agreed to host each year maximum two exchange students from the partner university for one or two semesters each within their LLB or LLM programmes. During the exchange, students will remain enrolled at their Home University which will recognize studies pursued at the Host University in the framework of the exchange programme for award of the degree. The exchange student will not be required to pay tuition fees to Host University.

GNLU students and alumni enrolling for the LLM in International Business Law programme of the University of Lausanne will get tuition fee reduction between 15% to 50% and will also be eligible for seeking a fee waiver or a scholarship according to the university regulations.

The arrangement also provides for the exchange of professors, researchers, PhD students between GNLU and University of Lausanne and for joint academic activities in other areas such as research projects, short courses, conferences etc.

With these new global partners, GNLU has now academic collaboration with 20 reputed overseas institutions in 13 countries across five continents.

GNLU Director Dr Shanthakumar said, “We at GNLU constantly strive to offer better global exposure and opportunities for our students, faculty and alumni to face the challenges posed by globalization. I am sure they will immensely benefit from the recently executed MoUs.”
