

First-ever Innovative Workshop on Professional Legal Ethics by GNLU



Gandhinagar, December 17, 2018: Gujarat National Law University, Gandhinagar offered an intense two-day Workshop on Professional Legal Ethics on 15-16 December, 2018 in campus. According to Workshop-Trainer, Dr K. Parameswaran, Associate Professor of Law, this Workshop by GNLU is the first in India to augment nobility of Indian legal profession through an innovative learning methodology where ethics is taken as skills-development to advance justice in society. Its aim is to reinforce values of ethics in life through law and legal reasoning. Trainer Dr K. Parameswaran says, “Often our biases, short-term gains, economic and social compulsions influence nobility of legal profession to lop-sided arguments through narrow individual and social behavior leading to injury and injustice at different levels. This ethics skills development (ESD) training brings core values of legal ideals and actions towards justice, good and truth for both individual and collectivity. Generally, ethics in any profession is given by instructions through do’s and don’ts. However, do’s and don’ts in real-life situations involve human-judgment on situations where choices bring dilemma as to ‘what is right and wrong’ in decisions-making. Participants of this training, advocates, academics and others took back home enriched professional perspectives for wholistic understanding of law and life in society to make their legal arguments adhere to Indian Constitutional values, Advocate’s Act 1961, core corporate ethics and essence of collective development with justice.
