About GNLU

Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) is a statutory university established by the Government of Gujarat under the Gujarat National Law University Act, 2003 and functions as the nodal agency to uplift legal education in the State. The University is recognised by the Bar Council of India (BCI) and the University Grants Commission (UGC). The University is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and is accredited with an 'A' Grade by NAAC.

The GNLU Act, 2003 proclaims that the objectives of the University shall be to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge of the law and legal processes and their role in national development, to develop in the students and research scholars a sense of responsibility to serve society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy, legal services, legislation, parliamentary practice, law reforms and such other matters; to make law and legal processes efficient instruments of social development; and to promote the interdisciplinary study of law with management, technology, international cooperation and development. The University is instrumental in providing multi-disciplinary, five-year integrated courses with general honours – B.A. LL.B., B.Com. LL.B., BBA LL.B., B.Sc. LL.B., and BSW LL.B.

GNLU is a legal institution with global outreach, which undertakes a continuous, dynamic process of creating legal minds who are par excellence professionals with an innate sense of social responsibility. With state-of-the-art research facilities and readily accessible campus infrastructure, students, faculty, and research fellows are well-equipped to pursue their research interests.

The University's Library is an ocean of knowledge with resources available on countless areas of law and provides access to online research databases and journals. Frequent interactions with the best legal minds through conferences, guest lectures and specialised courses provide a practical edge to the learning at the University. Since its establishment, the University has consistently pursued academic and professional excellence in imparting legal education.

In addition to the main campus in Gandhinagar, GNLU has established a campus at Silvassa in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu to offer quality legal education to aspiring professionals. The campus has already commenced its programmes for the academic year 2023-24.



About the Committee on Recruitment Affairs

University Initiatives



GNLU Litigation Assistance & Support Scheme (GLASS)

The GNLU Litigation Assistance & Support Scheme (GLASS) is an initiative by Gujarat National Law University to encourage and support talented students who pursue a career in litigation despite other attractive career options. The scheme provides financial assistance to graduating students with excellent academic and extracurricular achievements who strongly believe in litigation. GLASS began with the 2015 Batch, offering financial support to selected students, and has since expanded in both the number of recipients and the amount of assistance provided. This scheme has been well-received by legal professionals and parents, enhancing the quality of advocates joining the Bar and contributing to society.

Centres of Excellence

Gujarat National Law University boasts a wide range of Centres of Excellence dedicated to specialized areas of law and policy. These centers encompass diverse fields such as Foreign Policy, Sports and Entertainment Law, Environment, Sustainability, Climate Justice, Banking and Financial Laws, Business and Public policy, Constitutional and Administrative law, Intellectual Property Rights, Corporate and Insolvency Law, Law and Economics, Law and Society, Air and Space Law, Law and Technology, Criminal Justice Sciences, Women and Child Rights, legal history, and alternative dispute resolution. This comprehensive array of centers reflects the university's commitment to fostering interdisciplinary studies and promoting legal expertise across various domains.

Gujarat National Law University's Centres of Excellence organize flagship events that bring together industry experts, scholars, and practitioners to engage in thought-provoking discussions and cutting-edge research. Notable events include the GNLU-Khaitan & Co Advanced Certificate Programme on Capital Markets & Securities Laws, which provides in-depth knowledge of capital markets, securities laws, and practical applications. The 13th Asian Criminology Conference explored the impact of technology on law and criminal justice, inviting paper submissions from educators, researchers, and practitioners. Additionally, the 6th International Conference on Economic Analysis of Law, Governance, and Public Policy fostered interdisciplinary studies in law and economics, encouraging contributions from students, scholars, and professionals. These flagship events showcase the university's commitment to promoting intellectual discourse, advancing legal scholarship, and addressing contemporary legal challenges.

Legal Services Committee

The GNLU Legal Services Committee (LSC) was set up in the year 2007, by way of Section 4(k) of the Legal Service Authorities Act, 1987. Since its inception, the committee has strived to provide assistance to those in need through multitudinous methods including traditional casework, summary advice, self-help, community legal education and community development and policy reform initiatives. Over the years, the committee has constantly escalated its commitment towards providing quality legal assistance. Amongst its varying initiatives, the students of the present batch have introduced initiatives such as speed mentoring, street vendors' awareness, collaborations with Non-governmental organisation to start a helpline number for making legal aid more accessible, and spearheaded the committee to open its doors to impact centric legal aid work.



Academic Support Programme (ASP)

Gujarat National Law University's Academic Support Programme (ASP) was introduced in 2010 to enhance academic experiences and opportunities for students from diverse backgrounds. ASP provides additional study sessions beyond the regular curriculum, fostering a supportive and collaborative environment where students can share knowledge and assist each other. The program addresses challenges like language barriers and communication skills, promoting cooperation and knowledge exchange. ASP aims to create highly capable students equipped to face societal challenges collectively and has played a significant role in establishing stronger intellectual relationships among students.



GNLU Legal Incubation Council (GLIC)

The GNLU Legal Incubation Council (GLIC), established in 2016, aligns with GNLU's vision of fostering legal education and excellence and supporting entrepreneurial endeavours in law and interdisciplinary areas. With a grant from the State Government in 2017, it accelerated entrepreneurial activities and has supported 16 student-run startups since its inception. The main objectives of GLIC include promoting entrepreneurship and innovation among students, faculty, and alumni and developing the startup ecosystem in India. GNLU incubated startups in the past have been awarded by the Vice President of India and have won at various forums like Amazon DeepRace and Azure Hackathon, among others.

The Batch of 2025 has created a benchmark in innovation by founding startups like AltAlpha(2NLU), myMess, Casediary and various other early-stage ventures that aim to address challenges in emerging fields like the Social Stock Exchange and Online Dispute Resolution.

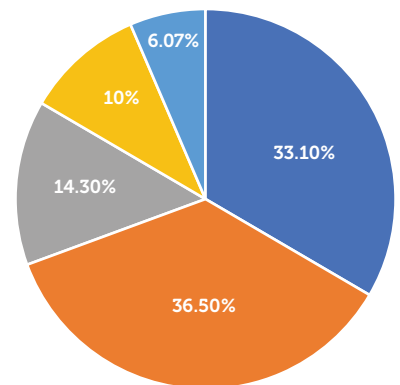
